



Keyed Indicator Deadbolts

In Group A occupancies having an occupant load of 300 or less; Groups B, F, M, and S; and in places of worship, the MAIN exterior door is permitted to be equipped with a **key-operated locking device** from the egress side, provided:

- The locking device is readily distinguishable as locked (must display “OPEN” or “LOCKED” as appropriate)
- A readily visible, durable sign is posted on the egress side on or adjacent to the door stating: THIS DOOR TO REMAIN UNLOCKED WHEN BUILDING IS OCCUPIED. The sign shall be in letters 1 inch high on a contrasting background.
- The use of the key-operated locking device is revocable by the fire code official for due cause.
