



## Fire Restrictions Guidelines



### ALLOWED

#### CONTAINED OPEN FIRES

- Fires contained in a permanently constructed, stationary, masonry or metal fireplace
- Fuel pile must be less than 3 ft wide x 2 ft tall.



#### HEATING & COOKING FIRES

- Fireplaces or wood stoves located inside permanent structures
- LPG or natural gas grills at private residences
- Compressed gas stoves and lanterns at developed campgrounds



#### CHARCOAL AND PELLET



- On non-combustible surface
- At least **ten (10)** feet from combustible surfaces in all directions

### NOT ALLOWED

#### OPEN FIRES



Recreational camp or cooking fires not in a permanently established fire ring

#### SMOKING



Smoking in the open is not allowed, except in areas that are cleared of all flammable materials for three feet in all directions.

#### FIREWORKS



Fireworks or firework displays without permit approval.



### PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES



- Any fire greater than 3 ft wide x 2 ft tall
- Burning trash, yard waste, slash
- Unattended fires
